In the 21st century, Boston emerged as a global leader in higher education and academic research. Greater Boston's many colleges and universities include Harvard University and MIT, both located in neighboring Cambridge and both routinely included among the world's most highly ranked universities.^[20] The city is also a national leader in scientific research, law, medicine, engineering, and business. With nearly 5,000 startup companies, the city is considered a global pioneer in innovation and entrepreneurship,^{[21][22][23]} and more recently in artificial intelligence.^[24]

Boston's economic base also includes [finance](#),^[25] professional and business services, [biotechnology](#), [information technology](#), and government activities.^[26] Households in the city claim the highest average rate of [philanthropy](#) in the United States.^[27] Boston businesses and institutions rank among the top in the country for environmental [sustainability](#) and new investment.^[28]
